

CONFERENCE LOCALISATION

Hotel Trzebnica is situated in the central part of The Trzebnickie Hills which are a part of picturesque Trzebnicki Ridge. The terrain profile of the entire area was formed during the last middle-Poland glacial period and includes over 60 km of moraine hills along the line drawn through cities Wińsko-Strupina-Osolin-Osola-Oborniki Śląskie-Trzebnica-Skarszyn-Dobroszyce-Twardogóra. The highest peaks of Trzebnickie Hills are Ciemna Góra (258,3 m above sea level) and Farna Góra (257 m). The oldest remains of human (*Homo erectus*) activity nowadays Poland, dated 0.5 million years BC were discovered on the slopes of Winna Góra in Trzebnica. The name of the city is derived from the word *Terbiti* which means "to cut trees" in ancient Slavian language. The town is situated just 21 km from Wrocław, the capital of The Lower Silesia region, a large multicultural and academic city, where 19 universities are located. Trzebnica and its surroundings are famous for its vast orchards, attractive hiking and cycling trails. Its famous and worth to see attractions are St. Hedwig's Basilica with the monastery, The Rotunda of Five Tables, The Forest Church, Beech Forest, Napoleon's Oak in Kuraszków, Singing Stone. Nearby is also a famous nature reserve of the river Barycz Valley.
